# Albuterol admin

### Albuterol (nebulizer)

# Indications (check all that apply): ☐ Asthma ☐ Chronic bronchitis ☐ Emphysema ☐ Smoke inhalation ☐ Severe shortness of breath (SOB) Contraindications (check all that apply): ☐ Pt allergic or hypersensitive to drug ☐ Pts with significant or symptomatic tachycardia (heart rate > 150, chest pain, SOB, decr LOC, shock, low BP)

## **Required documentation:**

Previous meds taken by pt Vitals before admin

Breath sounds before admin

Any allergies

Med admin time, dose, site

Any change in pt's ease of breathing, breath sounds, 5–10 mins after med admin

### Dose:

Adult: 2.5 mg in 3 mL liquid, may repeat every 15 mins as needed

Peds: 1 dose may be given prior to medical approval

### **Administration:**

Obtain baseline vitals

Listen to lung sounds

Fill nebulizer container, set O<sub>2</sub> to 6 L/M

Have pt breathe deeply, briefly holding an inhalation every 3–5 breaths as pt tolerates

Med may take 10–15 mins to completely nebulize; peak effect may take up to an hr

Reassess breath sounds after neb is done, and every 10–15 mins thereafter

### **Actions:**

Relaxes smooth muscle in the resp tract, which dilates bronchioles

Aids in decreasing SOB, wheezing, coughing, dyspnea

# **Possible Side effects:**

Palpitations Anxiety
Headache Dizziness
Rapid heart rate Tremors

Hypertension Nausea & vomiting (uncommon)
